Week's Reading: Luke 9:1-27
Discussion Guide: February 12, 2023

CHECK UP:

Memory work: He replied, "My mother and brothers are those who hear God's word and put it into practice." - Luke 8:21

In what particular way did you trust Jesus this past week?

OPEN:

- What stood out from this past week's reading?
- What is the most important question you have ever been asked?

READ and ASK: Luke 9:18-27

- How would you answer Jesus today if He asked, "Who do crowds say I am?"
- How have you viewed Jesus' question to the disciples compared to other important questions you've been asked?
 - o In what situations would you be uncomfortable stating plainly that Jesus is the Christ of God?
- Why do you think Jesus warned the disciples not to share what had been spoken in 9:20-21?
- In what way does 9:24 challenge you?
- How does this passage teach the true nature of discipleship?
 - o Do you think most people understand what it truly means to follow Jesus?
 - o How would you respond to someone who said, "the Bible teaches moderation in all things, that it doesn't have to be all or nothing" when it comes to faith in Jesus?

APPLY:

- What situations this week might give you the opportunity to speak about Jesus' identity this week?
 - o NEXT STEP: In what way do you need to deny yourself and fully follow Jesus?

Memory Work:

Then he said to them all: "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me. For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me will save it. - Luke 9:23-24
