OPEN:

- What was a highlight in your week this past week? What was a particular challenge you had?
- Who did you B.L.E.S.S. this past week? What action steps did you take?

READ and ASK: Genesis 1:26-31; 3:1-24; Exodus 34:5-7; 1 Corinthians 15:47-57; Romans 16:20; Revelation 22:1-5

- How do these verses show us the overarching story of the Bible?
- Why is it significant to understand we were created by God?
- Why is it significant that all humans were created in the image of God?
- Why is trusting that God is good (always) key to our faith?
 - o How did the serpent undermine the truth that God is good?
 - o How does he still do that for us today?

APPLY:

- What does it mean to you that even in the midst of the tragic story of the fall, that God announced his plan for the Messiah? (Genesis 3:15; Romans 16:20)
- In what ways do you struggle to trust in the goodness of God? How can this group help you?
- Why is it essential to see your daily walk through the lens of the biblical story?
