CHECK UP:

Memory Work: Dear friends, I urge you, as foreigners and exiles, to abstain from sinful desires, which wage war against your soul. Live such good lives among the pagans that, though they accuse you of doing wrong, they may see your good deeds and glorify God on the day he visits us. – 1 Peter 2:11-12

What truth from last week's text/sermon did you live out this week?

OPEN:

- Who did you B.L.E.S.S. this past week? What action steps did you take?

Throughout this series we are primarily going to use a modified Discovery Bible Study method. Each week (of 1 Peter) it will look very similar. The goal is obedience.

READ and ASK: 1 Peter 3:1-7

- What stood out to you in this text?
 - o What did you read that was new or fresh to you?
 - o What parts do you struggle with?
 - o What questions come to mind?
- What does this text teach us about God?
- What does this text teach us about ourselves?

APPLY:

- What has this text taught you about how a disciple of Jesus should live?
 - o How are you falling short of this (these) truths?
 - o How can this group help?
- Next step(s): What is one practical step you can live out this week?

Memory Work: (intentionally repeated)
